Charlottesville, Virginia (4/14/2016) – QuickStart Tennis of Central Virginia (QCV) is pleased to report tennis in PE has kids moving at E. A. Gibson Elementary School in Danville. PE teachers Dustin Cockram and Kirsten Marvin recently introduced their students to tennis with QuickStart activities in the gym. Danville PE teachers and other community members were trained on QuickStart in October 2015. QCV equipped five Danville elementary schools in January 2016 thanks to a grant from the Community Foundation of the Dan River Region.

Cockram says, "We decided to start with a tennis unit with our 3rd-graders this year. They were so excited about tennis. I was surprised at how many students had never played before. We made it through the first four lessons in the USTA curriculum guide. The kids enjoyed the warm-ups and liked the challenges. We plan to use the equipment with 4th- and 5th-graders next year. The kids had a blast! Thank you for this great opportunity!"



Lynda Harrill, QCV's QuickStart Tennis Coordinator and Founder, adds, "The Danville PE teachers have been super receptive and the kids are having a lot of FUN, so we are very pleased with our progress. Establishing 'long-distance' (from QCV's base in Charlottesville) relationships can be tricky, but not so in the case of Danville. With enthusiastic PE teachers like these and a community tennis 'maven' like Neda Haymore, QuickStart instructor at the Stratford Tennis Club, on our side, we have great expectations for kids and tennis in this part of Virginia."
