Tennis Continues To Grow in Southside Virginia

Charlottesville, Virginia (1/11/2017) – QuickStart Tennis of Central Virginia, Inc. (QCV) is pleased to report tennis is growing in southside Virginia. In addition to tennis in PE classes in Henry, Patrick and Pittsylvania, Danville and Martinsville and the BrightSTARS preschool programs in Danville and Martinsville, USPTA tennis professional and Martinsville native Rusty Lovell is expanding programming for kids of all ages and abilities in the region. In addition to teaching at Stratford Tennis Club last summer, Lovell partnered with Henry County Parks & Recreation to offer tennis at Jaycee Park. During the winter months, Lovell is running High Performance Clinics for kids on the indoor courts at Chatmoss Country Club on Thursday evenings and Saturday mornings. The clinics started in December and will continue through March. On Tuesday afternoons, Lovell is teaching tennis in the gym at Sacred Heart Catholic School for students from both Sacred Heart and Westover Christian Academy. A new after-school program for students at the Carlisle School starts this month. Lovell also has plans to visit PE classes in city and county public schools to promote tennis and help elementary and middle school PE teachers incorporate tennis into their PE curriculum.



We have also gotten tennis into PE classes in 30 additional schools with 14,000 students in southwestern and eastern central Virginia as part of the Mid-Atlantic Supercharge School Tennis Task Force.
