Vivi is nine years old and is currently ranked #3 in the Mid-Atlantic Section for Girls 10 and under. Eight-year-old Joshua is ranked #21 in the Boys 10 and under. Both Vivi and Joshua are coached by Christopher Cubbage of Matilda Blue Tennis.



Lynda Harrill, QuickStart Coordinator, says, "It is such a thrill to watch Vivi and Joshua play tennis. They are 'pure' QuickStart kids. Vivi attends public school and Joshua is homeschooled. Their parents are not members of a private club. These kids are the result of a public tennis tradition that was made possible with the introduction of the QuickStart Tennis format in 2008. All the seeds that have been planted are coming to fruition and there are more kids in the pipeline. It is a very exciting time for kids and tennis in our community."

QCV's service area includes Albemarle, Amelia, Appomattox, Brunswick, Buckingham, Charlotte, Culpeper, Cumberland, Dinwiddie, Fluvanna, Franklin, Greene, Greensville, Halifax, Henry, Louisa, Lunenburg, Madison, Mecklenburg, Nelson, Nottoway, Orange, Patrick, Pittsylvania, Prince Edward, Powhatan and Rappahannock counties and the cities of Charlottesville, Danville and Martinsville, We currently serve 141 schools with 67,000 kids, nine parks & recreation departments, three Boys & Girls Clubs and two YMCAs in 27 counties and three independent cities. We have also gotten tennis into PE classes in 28 additional schools in southwestern and eastern Virginia as part of the Supercharge School Tennis Task Force in the USTA/Mid-Atlantic Section which kicked off in August 2014 and runs for the current school year.
