QCV Adds Campbell County to Service Area

Charlottesville, Virginia (12/2/2021) – QuickStart Tennis of Central Virginia, Inc. (QCV) is pleased to report that we have recently added Campbell County to our service area, bringing the total number of counties and independent cities we serve to 31. This is our first expansion since 2014. Campbell County has a public school system with seven elementary and two middle schools and 7,800 students enrolled.

We are happy to welcome Concord Elementary as our 250th 'Tennis in PE' school. Due to COVID, we've been focused on preschooler enrichment and early childhood literacy for the past several years, so it's FUN to be back in 'Johnny Appleseed' mode again. Concord has about 400 students in PreK through fifth grade. Brandie has been teaching PE for 14 years and is so excited about teaching her kids to play tennis. We're excited about growing our footprint again. We're also excited that she has four 'QuickStart' kids herself, including a two-year-old who gets free books delivered home every month from Dolly Parton's Imagination Library. We're looking forward to training all Campbell PE teachers next year and getting them equipped."

QCV's service area includes, Amelia, Appomattox, Brunswick, Buckingham, Campbell, Charlotte, Culpeper, Cumberland, Dinwiddie, Fluvanna, Franklin, Greene, Greensville, Halifax, Henry, Louisa, Lunenburg, Madison, Mecklenburg, Nelson, Nottoway, Orange, Patrick Pittsylvania, Prince Edward, Powhatan and Rappahannock counties and the cities of Charlottesville, Danville and Martinsville, plus under a special arrangement, King George County. We currently serve 213 schools with 99,000 kids, 15 parks & recreation departments, three Boys & Girls Clubs and two YMCAs in 27 counties and three independent cities. We have also gotten tennis into PE classes in 37 additional schools with 16,000 students in communities outside our service area.
